# Our Lady of Sorrows – Annual Report / Parish Finance Summary

For the fiscal year July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020



#### Summary

Your Parish Finance Council is pleased to present to you this Annual Report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2020, providing you details of our financial results for fiscal year 2020, with comparison to prior years. Our goal in this Annual Report is to continue with the transparency of our finances so that all parishioners can see and easily understand our financial results.

#### The Good News:

- Income increased 5%, led by an increase of 10% in our annual collection and a 4% in our offertory. Our offertory from March to June, when we could not hold Mass due to COVID-19, was <u>equal to our prior year offertory</u>, thanks to a significant increase in mailed in and electronic payments. Electronic payments ensure continued recurring giving when we can't celebrate Mass together, and we encourage parishioners to consider this option.
- Operating expenses decreased ~6%, primarily due to a drop in salaries. Efficiencies were gained by the staff without a loss in services.
- In total, the Parish had a modest operating profit (\$13k) as compared to a large operating loss (\$38k) in the past fiscal year
- Many maintenance projects were completed, including the Bathroom/Kitchen in the rectory, the refurbishment of the Pieta, replacement of the fire alarm system in all buildings & the replacement of one of the furnaces in the church.
- The parish received a PPP loan from the government of \$62k in May, which has helped our cash balance. The PFC expects to receive a full forgiveness of this loan, which has not been reflected in our 2020 operating results.

#### The Challenge:

- The many maintenance projects generated a cash outflow of \$50k in the fiscal year, and additional projects must be addressed, including the resurfacing
  of the parking lot.
- We expect that the upcoming year (Jul 2020 to Jun 2021) will continue to require a limited Mass schedule and thus reduced offertory giving.

The PFC and staff are extremely grateful for the Parish community's generosity during this pandemic.

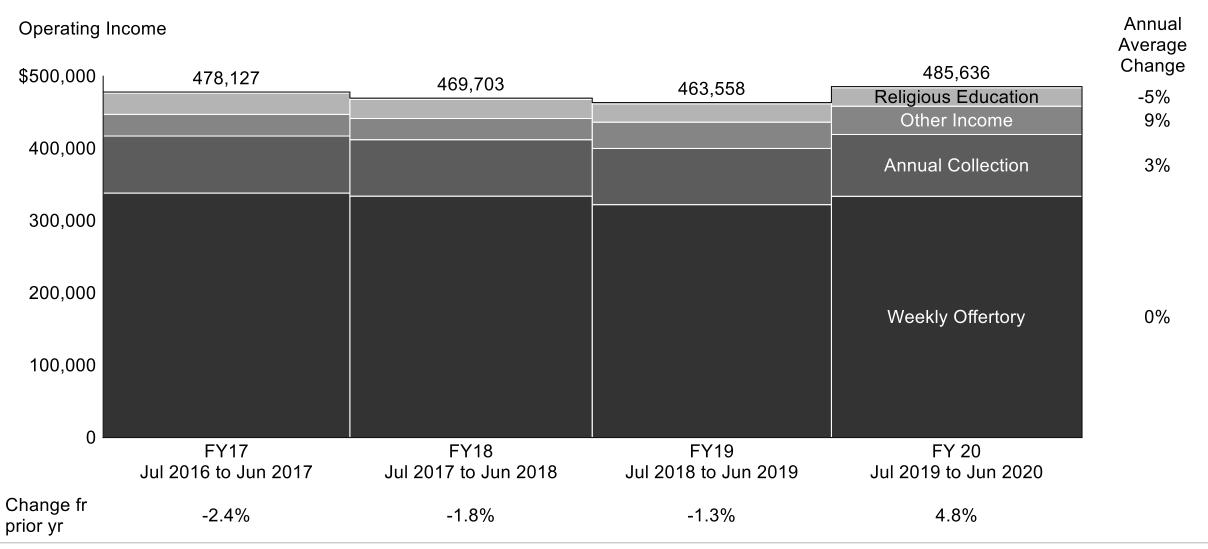

## Operating income and expenses showed significant improvement in FY2020

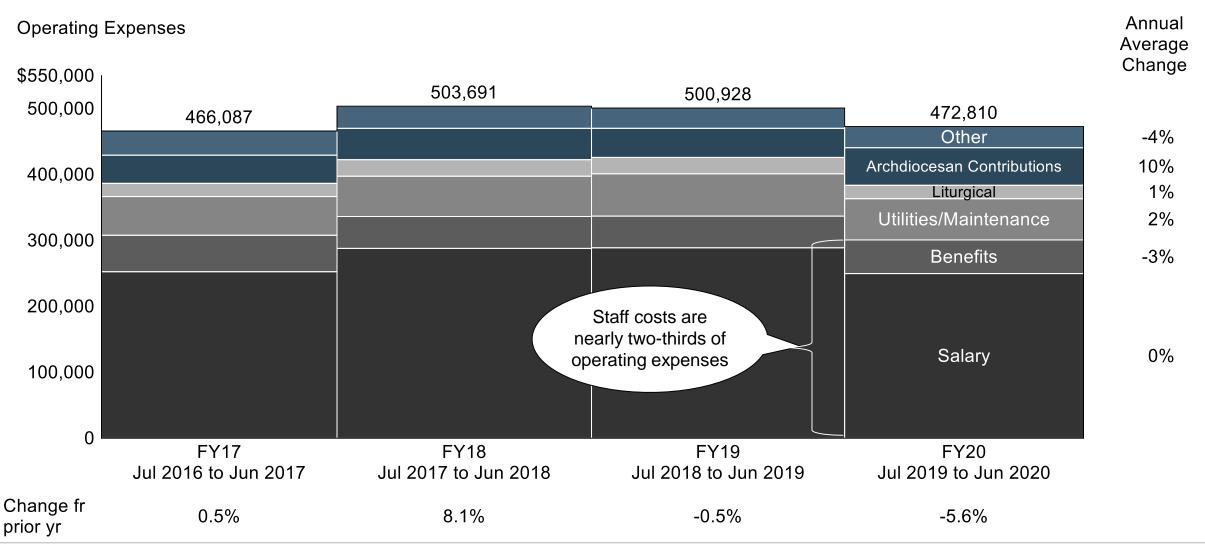

### Operating expenses down 6% from FY18 high



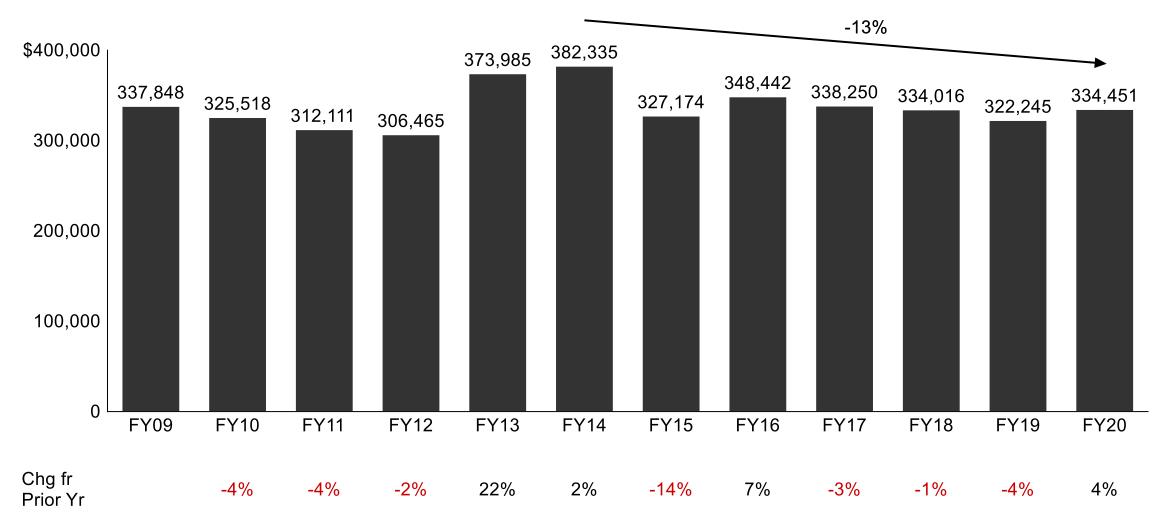

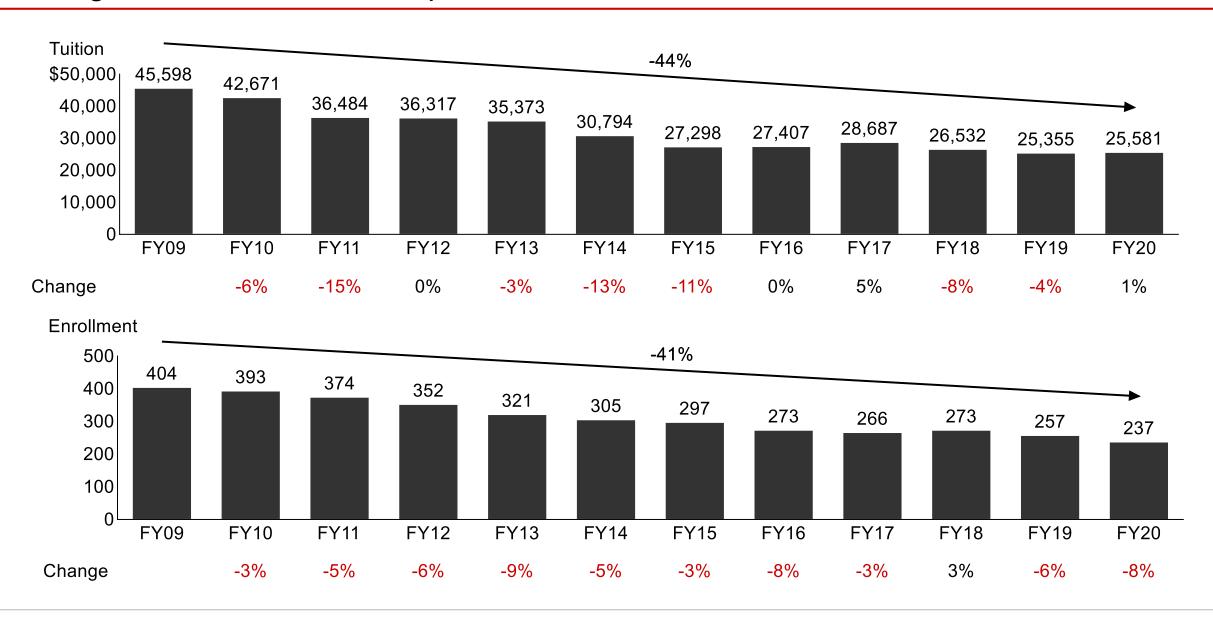

#### Offertory: Increase of 4% in 2020 - Decline of 13% since peak in fiscal year 2014

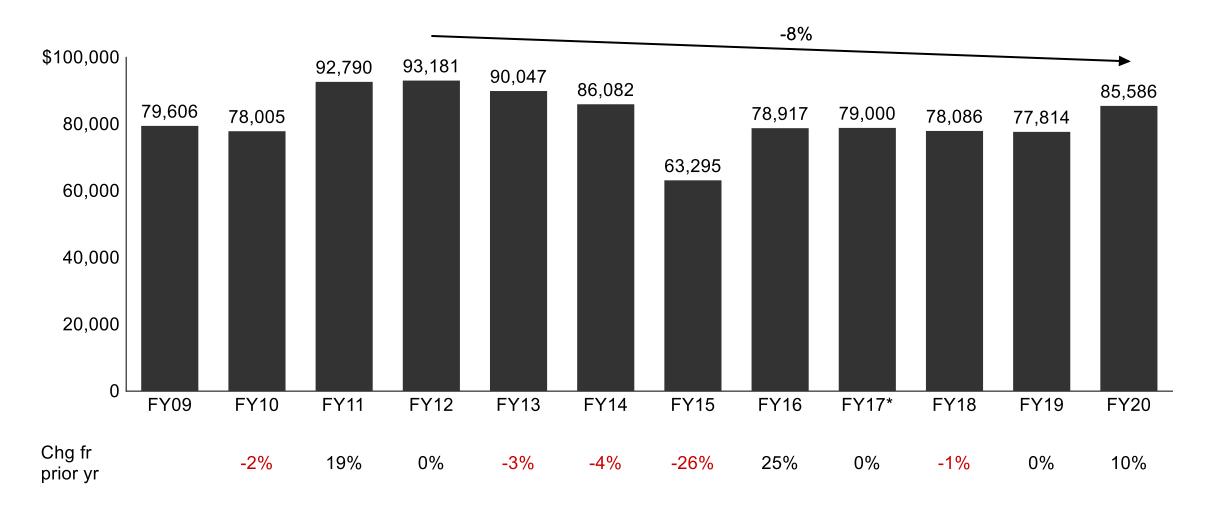

#### Religious Ed: FY20 tuition up 1%; Student enrollment down 8%

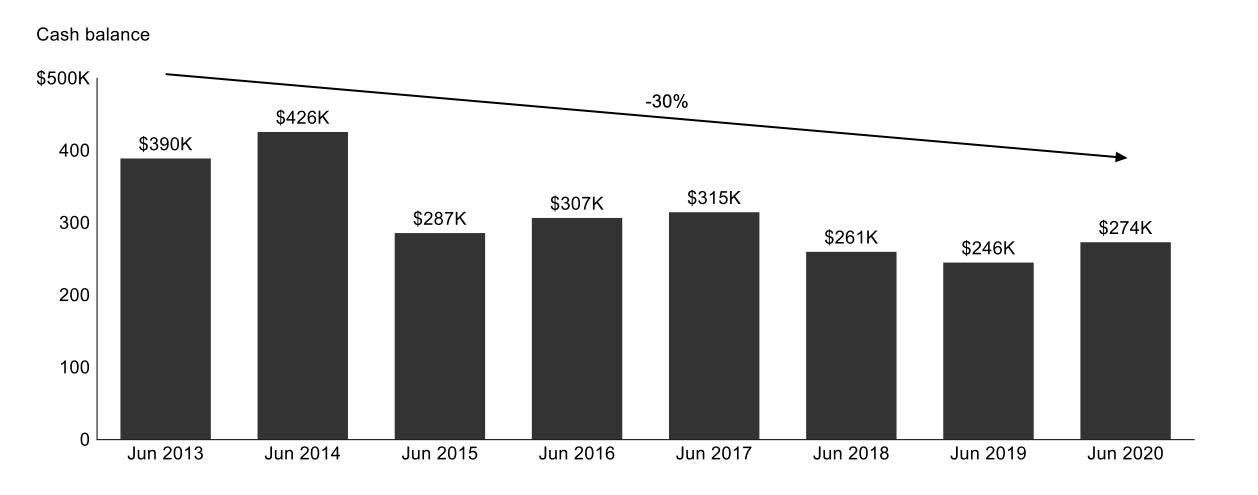


#### Annual collection: FY20 collection up 10%, but down 8% from FY12 peak

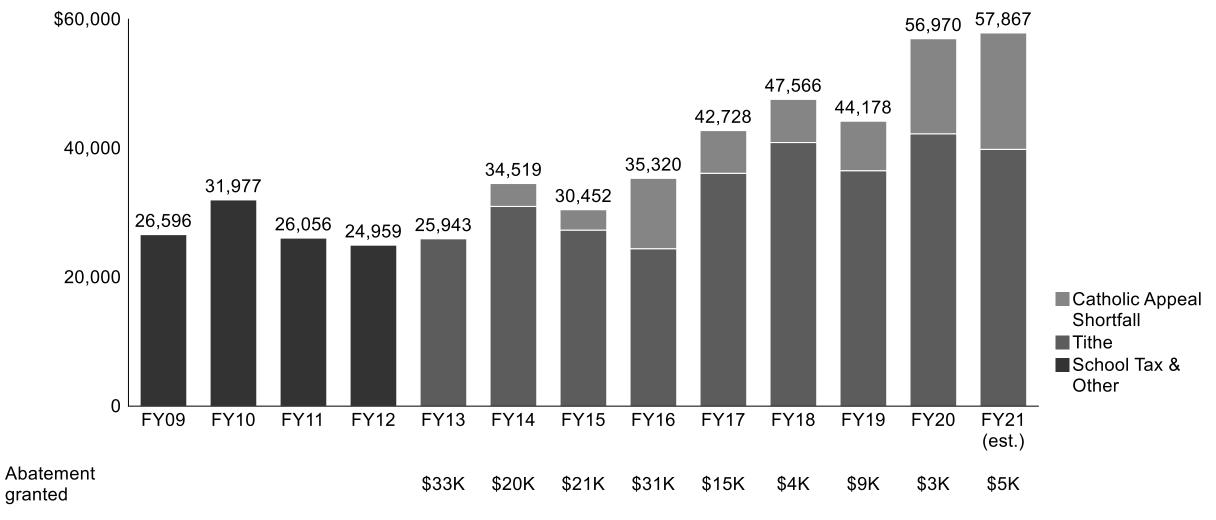
# Total cash in our bank accounts is down 30% since June 2013. Increase in 2020 helped by \$62k PPP funds.



#### Archdiocese Contribution: Explanation

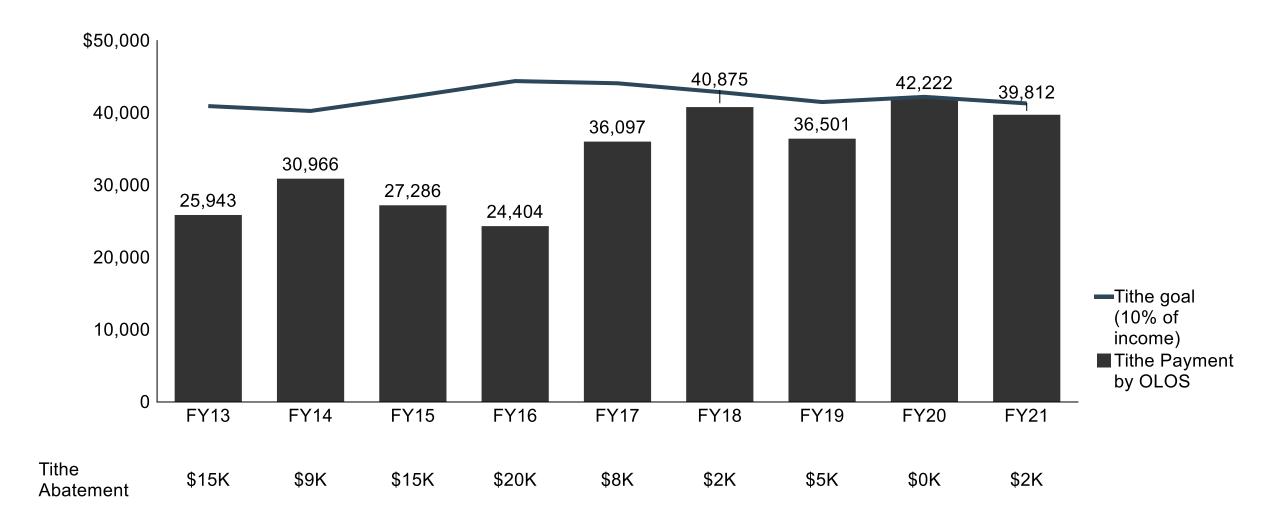
- In FY2013, the Archdiocese changed the way parishes assist in funding the central ministries of the diocese
  - > Prior to FY2013, parishes paid various and unequal School/Chaplaincy Tax amounts to the Archdiocese
  - > The new contributions simplified the process and ensured parishes in the diocese are paying their "fair share"
- The current contribution is made up of two payments that are based on parish income (3-year average offertory and annual collections):
  - > <u>Tithe:</u> Based on 10% of parish income
  - > <u>Catholic Appeal:</u> Calculated as the difference between our goal of 8% of parish income and the Catholic Appeal donations made by OLOS parishioners
- The Archdiocese allows parishes to request a reduction in payments ("Abatement") each year if there are special circumstances
  - > OLOS received Tithe and Catholic Appeal abatements from FY13 through FY20
  - > OLOS will receive a \$1.5k Tithe abatement for FY21 and any Catholic Appeal abatement will be determined in early 2021

#### Archdiocese Contribution History - Total

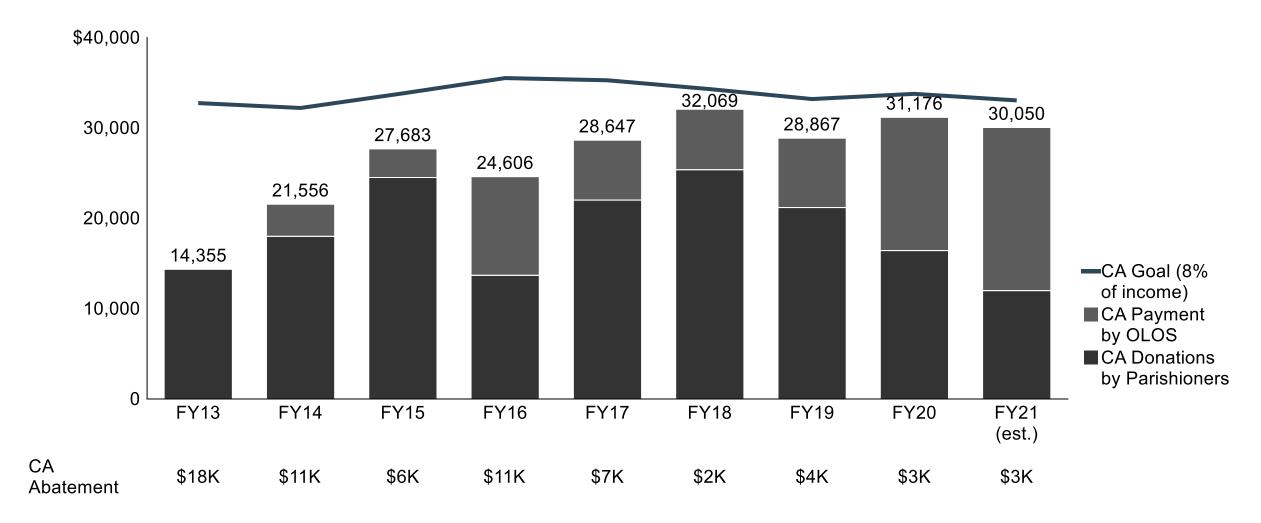
